Description of Activity:

Our office has received a SRP application from Bullhead Archery, Bullhead City Arizona., who propose the Archery Club Unlimited's sixth annual "Cinco de Marcho" competitive and non-competitive walk-around archery shoot over the weekend of March 19-21, 2004. The proposed area has been used in each previous year's event. The promoter anticipates 200 to 250 archers to attend the event, and up to 100 event-related spectators at the staging and shoot site.

Archery Club Unlimited would provide all parking, registration, staging, porta-potties, first aid, and vending within a 100% disturbed site located in a gravel (borrow) pit just south of Highway 163, approximately 1.5 miles west of Hiko springs. Practice targets would be set up in this area.

All entrants would be escorted to the competition area by open air towed trailers seating up to 20 passengers each to the adjacent low foothills where 4 to 5 archery fields would be located. Each field would be laid out in small ravines, behind boulders, and in washes along existing motorcycle course allowing undisturbed access to each stage.

All targets would be 3-dimensional styrofoam animal and silhouette targets. Entrants would be child to adult, amateur to expert, and factory professional shooters, competing in classes from traditional to free style unlimited.
