



**Description of Activity:** Our office has received a Special Recreation Permit application from Mitch Canepa, Searchlight Grand Prix Racing Association, for a motorcycle race in the Searchlight area as shown on the attached map to conduct the Searchlight Grand Prix motorcycle race within a 1.5-mile radius, east of the town of Searchlight. The course is approximately 14 miles long and follows existing roads and trails; and crosses BLM, Searchlight, and private property boundaries. The promoter will be responsible to obtain written permission from Searchlight and private property owners to cross their property before the BLM will issue a permit. The start/finish line, pits, and spectator area will all be confined to the Searchlight Community Center. The two-day event is expected to attract up to 300 participants. Not all participants will race at one time; rather, they will be broken down into several classes that will compete at various times during the course of two days, October 17-18, 2004, between 6:00 am and 6:00 pm each day. Up to 400 spectators are anticipated, but will be restricted to the spectator area at the Community Center. A drivers meeting is scheduled for 6:30 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday. The proposed course has been raced in the past during previous Searchlight Grand Prix events.

The racecourse will be marked with stakes and survey ribbon. Check points will be located along the course and race-monitors will observe participants to verify that they remain on the designated racecourse and will report any accidents/injuries. Emergency medical services will be onsite throughout the extent of the event. The race promoter will provide sanitation facilities and will clean up all litter, ribbon, markers, etc., associated with the proposed action. The race promoter will be subject to comply with all BLM/USFWS stipulations associated with SRP issuance and must rehabilitate any areas deemed to require restoration due to the proposed action. This proposed action is located outside of all Air Quality Non-attainment Zones as designated by Clark County Department of Air Quality.
