

TOiyabe NATIONAL FOREST

- Chains ground, blazed and scribed X-8-HES 47-BP, bears S 27° 30' E, 32 lks. dist. A cedar fence post, 5 ins. dia., extending 8 ft. above ground, blazed and scribed X-8-HES 47-BP, bears N 20° 19' W, 16 lks. dist. Thence N 47° 19' W.
- 10.12 To Cor. 9, identical with Cor. H/9 of listing survey, (and will be identical with Cor. 6 of HES 48) a granite stone, mkd. and witnessed as described by the Sur. Gen.; in place of which I set a granite stone 24 x 16 x 7 ins. 14 ins. in the ground, over a marked stone 16 x 16 x 7 ins., mkd. 9 HES 47 on side facing the claim, with cross (x) on top for Cor. 9 of this survey; No bearing objects available. Pits impracticable. Thence S 44° 53' W, along line 6-7 of HES 48.
- Across Meadow Canyon.
- 4.60 Meadow Creak, 3 lks. wide, 4 ins. deep, course SE.
- 6.29 Cor. 7 of HES. No. 48, a cedar fence post, marked 7-HES 48. Fence bears S 54° 30' E and N 33° W.
- 6.40 Road from Belmont to Round Mountain bears NW and SE.
- 7.14 To Cor. 10, identical with Cor. H/10 of listing survey, a granite stone, mkd. and witnessed as described by the Sur. Gen. in place of which I set a cedar post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. dia., 24 ins. in the ground over a marked stone 14 x 10 x 7 ins., blazed and scribed 10 HES 47 on side facing the claim, with cross (x) on top for Cor. 10 of this survey; A cedar fence post, 8 ins. dia., extending 10 ft. above ground, blazed and scribed X-10-HES 47-BP, bears N 45° 22' E, 85 lks. dist.
