The Cor., of Tps. 46 and 47 N., Rgs. 54 and 55 E., a stone mkd. and witnessed as described by the Sur. Gen., bears S. 78° 53' E., 158.83 chs. dist.
 Cor. 1 of H. E. Survey No. 69, a post, 4 ins. sq., showing 12 ins. above ground, mkd. 1-HES-69, bears S. 9° 14' 30" E., 93.52 chs. dist.

Thence

S. 71° 49' W.

Along wire fence.
 15.16 To Cor. No. 2, identical with Cor. H-4 of List 4-692, a stone, mkd. as described by the Sur. Gen., in place of which I set an aspen post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, over a stone mkd. 2-HES-67 on side facing the claim, with tack in top for Cor. 2 of this survey; no bearings, therefore dig pits, 24 x 24 x 12 ins., crosswise on this and the succeeding course, 7 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth and stone, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. dist., within the claim.

Wire fence, bears N. 71° 49' E. and S. 71° 49' W.

Slight descent, over grassy side hill.

20.04 To Cor. No. 3, identical with Cor. H-5 of List 4-692, a stone mkd. and witnessed as described by the Sur. Gen., in place of which I set an aspen post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground over a stone marked with a cross (x); marked 3-HES-67 on side facing the claim with tack in top for Cor. 3 of this survey; no bearings, therefore dig pits, 24 x 24 x 12 ins. crosswise on this and the succeeding course, 7 ft. dist.; and raise a mound
