Chains

46.02 To Cor. 5, about 80 ft. above point of ascent, for which I set a quartzite stone, 25 x 12 x 6 ins., 15 ins. in the ground, over a stone, 4 x 3 x 2 ins., mkd. with a cross (x), for Cor. 5 of this survey; mkd. 5-HES-77 on side facing the claim, and a cross (x) on top. No bearings, therefore, dig pits, 24 x 24 x 12 ins., crosswise on this and the succeeding course, 7 ft. dist.; and raise a mound of earth and stone, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. dist., within the claim.

Thence

N. 19° 25' E.,

Descend through sagebrush.

1.20 H-9 of List 4-968, which is a lava stone, firmly set, and mkd. as described by the Sur. Gen., N. 70° 00' W. 12 lks. dist. I destroy this corner.

Pass from unlisted land to List 4-968.

8.84 Wire fence bears NW. and SE.

12.95 To Cor. 5 of H. E. S. No. 66 (approved), which is a blue limestone, firmly set, showing 10 ins. above ground, mkd. 5-HES-66 on the NW. face, and a cross (x) on top, and witnessed by pits and a mound of earth.

15.30 Irrigation ditch, 4 lks. wide, 6 ins. deep, course SE.

16.50 Enter cultivation, bears E. and W.

24.98 Wire fence bears NE. and SW.

Leave cultivation, enter willows, bears E. and W.

25.08 To Cor. 6, about 80 ft. below Cor. 5, identical with Cor. H-10 of List 4-968, which is a lava stone, firmly set, mkd. as described by the Sur. Gen., and Cor. 4 of H. E. S. No. 66 (approved), which is a blue limestone, firmly set, showing 10 ins. above ground, mkd. 4-HES-66 on the W. face and a cross (x) on top, and witnessed by pits and a mound of earth.
