8.08	Leave meadow, enter sage bears NW. and SE. Ascend.	
16.30	To Cor. 9, about 25 ft. above point of ascent, on the line between the standard of Secs. 32 and 33 and the standard $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. on the S. bdy. of Sec. 33, T. 46 N., R. 54 E., I set a lava stone, 24 x 16 x 10 ins., 24 ins. in the ground, over a sandstone, 3 x 2 x 2 ins., mkd. with a cross (x) for closing Cor. and Cor. 9 of this survey; mkd. CC on the N. face, and 9-HES-81 on the W. face, and a cross (x) on the top; dig pits 24 x 18 x 12 ins., crosswise on the Standard Parallel, E and W., 3 ft. dist., dig a pit, 24 x 18 x 12 ins., crosswise on the closing line, N. 0° 15' E., 7 Ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, on the closing line, N. 0° 15' E., $3\frac{1}{4}$ ft. dist. No bearing objects available. The Standard $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. on the S. bdy. of Sec. 33 hereto- fore described, bears East, 29.24 chs. dist. The witness Cor. to the Standard Cor. of Secs. 32 and 33, heretofore described, bears West, 11.69 chs. dist. Thence S. 0° 15' W., 11.69 chs. dist.	
2.58	Descent along sagebrush side hill.	
6.10	Fence bears NE. and SW. To Cor. 10, about 20 ft. below Cor. 9 identical with Cor. H-7 of list 4-427 which is a lava stone, firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described by the Sur. Gen., in place of which I set a lava stone, 24 x 14 x 10 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, over a piece of petrified wood, 4 x 3 x 3 ins., mkd. with a cross (x) for cor. 10 of this survey; mkd. 10-HES-81 on the side facing the claim,
