Chains

The cor. of Secs. 15, 16, 21, and 22, T. 8 N., R. 42 E., which is a granite stone, firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. with 3 notches on the E. face, and 3 notches on the S. face, bears S. 19° 40' E., 254.79 chs. dist.

The cor. of Secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16, T. 8 N., R. 42 E., which is a cedar stake, 2 ins. sq., showing 2 ft. above ground, set in a mound of stone, mkd. 15 on the SE. face, and 16 on the SW. face, bears S. 25° 53' E., 179.93 chs. dist. Other markings than those above described have been scribed on this stake but were illegible on account of weathering.

Cor. 1 of H. E. Survey No. 83, which is a granite stone, firmly set, showing 10 ins. above ground, mkd. 1-HES 83 on NW. face, and a cross (x) on the top, and witnessed by pits and mound of earth, bears N. 77° 27' W., 24.30 chs. dist.
