Chains From these observations I calculate the bearing of a reference stake, firmly set, centered with a tack, 5 chs. from my station as (1) N. 50° 47' 18" E., and (2) N. 50° 47' 22" E. The mean of these is N. 50° 47' 20" E., and to the corresponding meridian all courses of this survey are referred.

Mean Mag. Decl., 17° 30' E.

Beginning at Cor. 1 of this survey, identical with Cor. H-5 of the listing survey, a granite stone, firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described by the Sur. Gen., in place of which I set a quartzite stone, 26 x 16 x 9 ins., 16 ins. in the ground, over a piece of strap iron, 12 ins. long; mkd. 1-HES-85 on side facing the claim, and a cross (x) on the top, for Cor. 1 of this survey; and raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. dist., within the claim.

A quartz rock, in place, 3 x 2 ft., showing 1 ft. above ground, mkd. x-1-HES-85-BR, bears S. 0° 45' E., 186 lks. dist.

A quartzite rock, in place, 3 x 3 ft., showing 1½ ft. above ground, mkd. x-1-HES-85-BR, bears N. 40° 39' E., 24 lks. dist.

I destroy the witnesses for listing Cor. H-5.

The Standard Cor. of Secs. 35 and 36, T. 16 N., R. 49 E., which is a post, 2 ins. square, showing 2 ft. above ground, set in a mound of stone, mkd. SC on the south face, R-49-E-xxxvi on the east face, and T. 16 N. xxxv on the west face; bears N. 0° 2' W., 142.99 chs. dist.

Thence S. 58° 28' E.,

Over sage brush land; descend
