	<p>A granite boulder, in place, 8 x 3 ft. x 18 ins., above ground, mkd. X-4-HES-91-BR, bears N. 78° 08' W., 47 lks. dist.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Thence East</p> <p>Descend gently through sagebrush.</p>
3.96	Leave sagebrush, enter aspen, bears N. and S.
4.00	Creek, 2 lks. wide, 2 ins. deep, flows S.
6.60	Road, bears N. and S.
7.60	Creek, about 20 ft. below Cor. 4, 5 lks. wide, 2 ins. deep, flows S.
	Ascend.
14.90	Leave aspen, enter sagebrush, bears N. and S.
19.97	<p>To Cor. 5, about 20 ft. above Creek, previously mkd. by temporary stake, in place of which I set a granite stone, 24 x 12 x 6 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, over broken glass, for closing cor. and Cor. 5 of this survey, mkd. CC on the W. face, 5-HES-91 on the SW. face, and a cross (x) on top, on line bet. Secs. 13 and 18, T. 45 N., Rgs. 54 and 55 E., and dig pits, 30 x 24 x 12 ins., N. 0° 28' W., and S. 0° 28' E., 4 ft. dist., crosswise on line, and dig a pit, 30 x 24 x 12 ins., 8 ft. to the <sup>W</sup>., crosswise on line; and raise a mound of stone, 5 ft. base, 2½ ft. high, 4 ft. dist., <sup>West</sup> on the closing line.</p> <p>Cor. H-4 of the listing survey, which is a granite stone, firmly set, mkd. as described by the Sur. Gen., bears E., 3 lks. dist. I destroy this cor.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Thence S. 0° 28' E.,</p> <p>Descend through sagebrush.</p>
