 post, showing 10 ins. above ground, mkd. 7-HES-64,
 and centered with a nail, being in sight, bears S.
 9° 50' E., 21.40 chs. dist.
 Thence S. 24° 18' E., 34 x 34 x 18
 N. 61° 46' W.,
 Descend through sagebrush.
 1.97 Leave sagebrush, enter willows, bears N. and S.
 6.99 Merrit Creek, about 20 ft. below Cor. No. 1, 15 lks.
 wide, and 3 ft. deep, flows NW.
 Ascend.
 8.00 Road bears NE. and S.
 11.05 Fence cor. bears N. 3 lks. dist., from which fences
 bear NE. and NW.
 11.06 Irrigation ditch, 3 lks. wide, and 6 ins. deep, course
 NW.
 13.91 Leave willows, enter sagebrush and grassland, bears
 N. and S.
 19.82 Summit of ridge, about 50 ft. above Merrit Creek, bears
 N. and S.
 Descend.
 40.30 Fence cor. bears N. 3 lks. dist., from which fences
 bear NE., NW., and SE.
 53.00 Cor. H-7 of List 4-1413, which is a lava stone, firmly
 set, mkd. H-7 on west face.
 75.76 Road bears NE. and SW.
 77.50 Irrigation ditch, 3 lks. wide and 12 ins. deep, course
 NE.
 80.27 Willis Creek, about 50 ft. below point of descent, 20
 lks. wide and 2 ft. deep, flows NE.
