Time to noon 2 h. 56.1 m.

Add to 7 h. 40. m

Argument 10 h. 36.1 m.

Azimuth of Polaris = N. 0° 32' W.

Bearing of reference stake = N78° 56' W.

The mean of these two observations is N. 78° 56' 45" W.,

and to the corresponding meridian all courses of
this survey are referred.

Mean Mag. Decln. = 18° 50' E.

Beginning at Cor. 1, which is a limestone, 26 x 14 x 9

ins., set 16 ins. in the ground, over broken

glass, for Cor. 1 of this survey, mkd. 1-HES-93

on side facing the claim and a cross (x) on top;

and raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 2 ft.

high, 3½ ft. dist. within the claim.

Cor. H-8 of the listing survey, which is a lime boulder,

The Cor. of Secs. 34 and 35 (survey accepted), T. 46 N.,

R. 53 E., which is a trachite stone, firmly set,

showing 8 ins. above ground, mkd. SC on the N.,

2 notches on the E. and 4 notches on the W., and
