stone, firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. 3

notches on the E. and 4 notches on the S., and

witnessed by a mound of stone to the NE., 3 ft. dist.

39.90 Fall 2 lks. W. of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. bet. Secs. 9 and 10, which is a granite stone, 8 x 10 x 12 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  on the W. face, and witnessed by a mound of stone to the W., 2 ft. dist.
