Chains

- Along broken hill side, through sagebrush and grass.
- 63.65 Road bears NW. and SE.
- 76.17 To Cor. 2, identical with Cor. H-2 of the listing survey, which is a lava stone, firmly set, mkd. as described by the Sur. Gen., in place of which I set a malapai stone, 24 x 14 x 5 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, over broken glass for Cor. 2 of this survey, mkd. 2-HES-106 on side facing the claim, and a cross (+) on top, and raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. dist., within the claim.
- A granite boulder in place, 5 x 2 x 1 ft. above ground, mkd. +-2-HES-106-BR, bears N. 47° 47' W., 60 lks. dist.
- A portion of a granite outcrop, 6 x 4 x 3 ft. above ground, mkd. +-2-HES-106-BR, bears S. 79° 37' E., 48 lks. dist.
- Cor. 7 of H.E.S. 107 (unapproved), which is a granite stone, showing 10 ins. above ground, mkd. 7-HES-107 on the southeast face and a cross (+) on top, and witnessed by pits and a mound of earth, being in sight, bears S. 35° 01' W., 12.50 chs. dist.
- Thence
S. 81° 37' W.,
- Descend, through sagebrush and grass.
- 4.00 Leave sagebrush and enter willows, bears N. and S.
- 4.90 Sheep Creek, about 60 ft. below Cor. 2, 20 lks. wide and 2 ft. deep, flows N.
- Ascend.
- 5.00 Leave willows, enter sagebrush and grass, bears N. and S.
- 8.75 Top of bench, about 60 ft. above Sheep Creek.
- Across level land.
- 19.45 Road bears N. and S.
