Thence

N. 32° 02' W.,

Ascend through sagebrush and grass

Along fence line.

12.01 Irrigation ditch, 3 lks. wide and 10 ins. deep, course
N:

12.03 West cor. of corral, from which fences bear NW., SE.
and SW.

12.50 North cor. of corral, from which fences bear NW., SE., and SW.
16.07 Irrigation ditch, 3 lks. wide and 10 ins. deep, course

NW,

30.08 To Cor. 5, about 40 ft. above Cor. 4, identical with
Cor. H-1 of List 4-767, and Cor. H-1 of List 4-1557,
which is a wooden post, firmly set, mkd. as des-
cribed by the Sur. Gen., alongside Cor. 4 of H. E.
S. 92 (unapproved), which is a granite stone, 24 x
16 x 12 ins., set 14 ins. in the ground, over
broken glass, mkd. 4-HES-92 on the SW. face, and a
cross (x) on top, and witnessed by pits and a mound
of earth. I destroy the listing cors. and mark
the stone last described 5-HES-107 on the north
face, for Cor. 5 of this survey. No bearings,
therefore dig pits, 24 x 24 x 12 ins., crosswise
on this and the succeeding course, 7 ft. dist.;
and raise a mound of earth and stone, 4 ft. base,
2 ft. high, 3½ ft. dist., within the claim.

N. 67° 55' W.,

Leave List 4-1557, enter List 4-767

On true line to Cor. 3 of H. E. S. 92, being in sight

Descend gently through sagebrush and grass, leave fence,
which bears N. and SE.

6.93 Leave sagebrush and grass, enter meadow, bears N. and S.
