R. 57 E., mkd. with a cross (x), for closing cor.,

and Cor. No. 11 of this survey, mkd. CC on the NW

face, 11-HES-117 on the side facing the claim, and

a cross (x) on top. Dig pit, 30 x 24 x 12 ins.,

crosswise on section line, N. 89° 42' E., 3 ft.

dist., and dig a pit, 24 x 18 x 12 ins., crosswise

on the closing line, N. 35° 22' W., 7 ft. dist.,

and raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high,

on the closing line, N. 35° 22' W., 3 1/2 ft. dist.

A cedar tree, 8 ins. in dia., blazed and scribed X-11-

HES-117-BT-CC, bears N. 46° 02' E., 95 lks. dist.
