post, showing 4 ft. above ground, firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General, in place of which I set a granite rock, 27 x 6 x 6 ins., 17 ins. in the ground, over broken glass, for Cor. No. 1 of this survey, mkd. 1-HES-151 on the side facing the claim, and a cross (x) on top, and raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. dist., within the claim.

A cedar tree, 8 ins. in dia., blazed and scribed X-1 HES-151-BT, bears S. 85° 26' E., 172 lks. dist.

A cedar tree, 10 ins. in dia., blazed and scribed X-1 HES-151-BT, bears S. 24° 24' E., 172 lks. dist.

U. S. Locating Monument No. 278, (unapproved), which is a granite ledge, showing 25 ft. above ground, mkd. USLM-278 on the west face and a cross (x) on top, properly witnessed by two bearing trees, a bearing rock, and a mound of stone, being in sight, bears S. 40° 41' E., 1.57 chs. dist.

Cor. No. 5 of H. E. Survey No. 118, (unapproved), which is a sandstone, 30 x 12 x 6 ins., firmly set, 20 ins. in the ground, mkd. 5-HES-118 on the SE. face, a cross (x) on top, and properly witnessed, bears S. 57° 42' E., 87.36 chs. dist., by traverse as follows, computations of which are hereto attached.

S. 40° 41' E., 1.57 chains

S. 38° 52' E., 49.82 "

S. 86° 21' E., 32.69 "

S. 62° 39' E., 10.07 "

S. 81° 12' W.
