The witness cor. to the 95th mile post on the Nevada-Idaho State line, which is a granite stone, firmly set, mkd. WC-95-M on the E. face; N. on the S. face, and I-42-L on the N. face, being in sight, bears N. 33° 14' E., 20.78 chs. dist.

The witness cor. to M. P. 95 was set alongside M. P. 95 and is identical therewith.

Thence

S. 43° 59' E.,

35.48 Over broken sagebrush land.

0.03 Fence bears NE. and SW. Fence corner bears NE., 30 lks. dist.

42.17 Easterly corner of house, bears SW., 20 lks. dist.

42.67 Spring branch, 1 link wide, 1 inch deep, flows SW.

65.80 Creek, 6 lks. wide, 6 ins. deep, flows W.

Leave sagebrush; enter willows, bears E. and W.

66.92 Leave willows; enter sagebrush, bears E. and W.

Ascend.

71.00 Fence bears NW. and SE.

71.97 To Cor. No. 2, about 60 ft. above creek, identical with

Cor. No. 1, and identical with the Forest Service

Monument of the listing survey, which is a lava

stone, firmly set, mkd. as described by the Sur-

veyor General, in place of which I set an iron

post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., equipped with

a brass cap, 26 ins. in the ground, for Cor. No.

2 of this survey; mkd. 2-HES-168 in the W. quad-

rant, and a cross (x) in the center. No bearings,

therefore, dig pits, 24 x 24 x 12 ins., crosswise

on this and the succeeding course, 7 ft. dist.;

and raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft.

high, 3 1/2 ft. dist., within the claim.
