Chains

Fence cor. bears SE. 5 lks. dist., from which fences
bear NW. and SW.
Thence
S. 45° 47' W.,
Descend.
Over sagebrush land.
0.05 Fence bears NW. and SE.
12.10 Dry wash drains NW., about 25 ft. below Cor. No. 2.
Ascend.
22.05 Fence bears NW. and SE.
Fence cor. bears SE. 5 lks. dist., from which fences
bear NE. and NW.
22.15 To Cor. No. 3, about 60 ft. above point of ascent,
identical with Cor. No. 2 of the listing survey,
which is a lava stone, firmly set, mkd. and
witnessed as described by the Surveyor General,
in place of which I set an iron post, 3 ft. long,
2 ins. in dia., equipped with a brass cap, 26 ins.
in the ground, for Cor. No. 3 of this survey; mkd.
3-HES-168 in the north quadrant, and a cross (x)
in the center; and raise a mound of stone, 4 ft.
base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. dist., within the claim.
No bearing objects available. Pits impracticable.
I destroy the witness to the listing corner which was
not suitable for a bearing object for this survey.
Cor. No. 1 of H. E. S. No. 235, which is an iron post,
firmly set in a mound of stone and properly mkd.,
bears S. 30° 37' E., 58.18 chs. dist., by traverse
(Computations of which are hereto attached), as
follows:
