40.00 After diligent search I am unable to find any trace of the $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. between Secs. 19 and 24.

Beginning at the $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. bet. Secs. 13 and 18, heretofore described, I run

On a true line between Secs. 13 and 18.

16.58 Set a temporary stake for closing cor. and Cor. No. 2 of this survey.

40.00 Set a granite stone, 24 x 20 x 5 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, over broken glass, for the cor. of Secs. 13,

18, 19, and 24; T. 15 N., Rgs. 46 and 47 E., mkd. 3 notches on the N., and 3 notches on the S. edges;

no bearings, therefore dig pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., diagonally in each section, $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raise

a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3 ft. dist. to the west.

BEGINNING AT COR. NO. 1 of this survey, identical with the $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. between Secs. 13 and 18, T. 15 N., Rgs.

46 and 47 E., (survey accepted), heretofore described, I mark the stone with a cross (+) on top
