

Chains

A pinon pine, 8 ins. in dia., scribed in blaze X-1-HES-200-BT, bears S. $39^{\circ} 23'$ W., 188 lks. dist.

A pinon pine, 7 ins. in dia., scribed in blaze, X-1-HES-200-BT, bears S. $60^{\circ} 38'$ E., 125 lks. dist.

U. S. Locating Monument No. 257, which is a granite boulder, in place, showing 6 x 6 x 6 ft. above ground, mkd. X-USLM-257 and witnessed by a mound of stone and two bearing objects, being in sight, bears N. $80^{\circ} 08'$ W., 5.96 chs. dist.

Fence bears NW. and SE.

Thence

N. $81^{\circ} 18'$ W.

Over rolling sagebrush land.

58.42 To Cor. No. 2, identical with Cor. No. 3 of the listing survey and identical with Cor. No. 1 of H.

E. Survey No. 148 (approved), which is a blue limestone, firmly set, showing 12 x 10 x 8 ins.,

above ground, mkd. 1-HES-148 on the NW. face for Cor. No. 1 of H. E. S. No. 148 (approved) and

H-3 on the E. face for Cor. No. 3 of List No.

4-2233, and witnessed by a mound of stone and by two bearing rocks. I obliterate the markings on

this stone for Cor. No. 3 of the listing survey

and mark it 2-HES-200 on the east face for Cor.

No. 2 of this survey. Raise a mound of stone,

4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., within the claim.

A limestone, in place, showing 1 x 1 x 1 ft. above ground, bears N. $87^{\circ} 47'$ W., 16 lks. dist.

A limestone, in place, showing 2 x 1 x 1 ft. above ground, bears S. $13^{\circ} 42'$ W., 32 lks. dist.

Both stones mkd. X-2-HES-200-BR.
