Chains

U. S. Locating Monument No. 294 as follows: I mark a cross (x) and USLM-294 on an exposed porphyry ledge at about the center of a flat top rocky knoll, about one acre in extent, and rising about 40 ft. above Willow Creek. This knoll is located at the junction of Willow Creek and a dry wash running to the SW. and is a prominent feature of the local topography; raise a mound of stone, 6 ft. base, 4 ft. high, 5 ft. dist. E. of the monument.

A porphyry ledge, 7 x 5 1/2 x 2 ft. bears S. 78° 53' E.,

" 137 lks. dist.

A porphyry ledge, 7 x 4 x 3 ft., bears S. 0° 12' W.,

" 252 lks. dist.

Both ledges mkd. X-USLM-294-BR.

A house located on H. E. Survey No. 99 (accepted), bears

" S. 18° 15' E., about three-quarters of a mile dist.

No other prominent objects available for references.

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BEGINNING AT COR. NO. 1 of this survey, identical with Cor. No. 1 of the listing survey, and identical with Cor. No. 4 of H. E. S. No. 99 (accepted), which is a granite stone, firmly set, showing 14 x 10 x 6 ins. above ground, mkd. 4-HES-99 on the W. face and a cross (x) on the top and witnessed by two bearing rocks and by a mound of stone. I take the cross (x) on this stone for chaining and angle point for Cor. No. 1 of this survey, and mark it 1-HES-201 on the S. face; and raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3 1/2 ft. dist., within the claim.

A porphyry ledge, showing 6 x 6 x 2 ft. above ground, bears S. 45° 03' E., 66 lks. dist.

A porphyry ledge, showing 3 1/2 x 3 1/2 x 2 1/2 ft. above ground, bears N. 89° 41' E., 98 lks. dist.

Both rocks mkd. X-1-HES-201-BR.
