Chains

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(529460) 89 iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., equipped with brass cap, 26 ins. in the ground, over broken glass, for Cor. No. 2 of this survey; mkd. 2-HES-204 in the W. quadrant and a cross (x) in the center and raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3 1/2 ft. dist., within the claim.

Pits impracticable. No bearing objects available.

Thence from post S. 29° 54' E. 38 ins. in dia. with a brass cap, 26 ins. in the ground over sagebrush land.

Descend.

1.80 Dry wash drains SW., about 20 ft. below Cor. No. 2. Ascend.

4.00 Edge of placer ditch, about 5 ft. above point of ascent. Descend.

9.50 Placer ditch, 3 lks. wide, 6 ins. deep, flows E.

16.41 To Cor. No. 3, about 100 ft. below point of descent, identical with Cor. No. 7 of H. E. S. No. 93 (accepted), which is a porphyry stone, firmly set, showing 10 x 10 x 10 ins. above ground, mkd. H-8 on the W. face for Cor. No. 8 of the listing survey; 7-HES-93 on the E. face, and a cross (x) on the top for Cor. No. 7 of H. E. S. No. 93 (accepted) and witnessed by pits and by a mound of earth and stone. I deface the markings on this stone for Cor. No. 8 of the listing survey and mark it 3-HES-204 on the W. face for Cor. No. 3 of this survey and raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3 1/2 ft. dist., within the claim.

No bearing objects available. Pit on line 3-2 impracticable.
