## Chains

The Forest Service Monument and Cor. No. 1 of the listing survey, which is a granite rock in place, mkd. and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General, bears N. 75° 00' E., 9 lks. dist.

I obliterate the markings on this cor. and on the witnesses thereto.

A slight change was made in the position of this cor. in order to get a better location.

Cor. No. 1 of H. E. S. No. 172, (accepted), which is a granite stone, firmly set, showing 10 x 10 x 8 ins. above ground, mkd. 1-HES-172 on the SW. face and a cross (x) on the top, and witnessed by a mound of stone and by two bearing rocks, being in sight, bears N. 68° 04' W., 40.03 chs. dist.

Thence

S. 22° 58' E.

Ascend over sagebrush land.

4.00 About 35 ft. above Cor. No. 2.

Descend.

16.60 Fence, bears NW. and SE.

26.88 To Cor. No. 3, about 90 ft. below point of descent,

identical with Cor. No. 2 of the listing survey, which is a granite stone, firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General, in place of which I set a granite stone, 30 x 20 x 10 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, to bedrock, and supported by a mound of stone, over broken glass for Cor. No. 3 of this survey; mkd. 3-HES-218 on the side facing the claim, and a cross (x) on the top. Raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. dist., within the claim.

A cedar tree, 12 ins. in dia., mkd. X-3-HES-218-BT,
