	Over rolling buckbrush land along line 8-7 of H. E. S. No. 74 (accepted)	
11.00	Descend.	
15.35	Ditch, 2 lks. wide 3 ins. deep, flows SE., about 35 ft. below point of descent. Leave buckbrush, enter cultivation, bears NE and SW. Over level land.	
25.40	Ditch, 4 lks. wide, 6 ins. deep, flows SE.	
29.98	To Cor. No. 3, identical with Cor. No. 7 of H. E. S. No. 74 (accepted), which is a lava stone, firmly set, heretofore described, I mark this stone 3-HES-223 on the SE. face for Cor. No. 3 of this survey. A N. and S. fence bears E., 5 lks. dist. Thence S. 0° 05' E. Over level cultivated land along fence: Along line 2-1 of H. E. S. No. 73 (accepted).	
2.73	Ditch, 4 links wide, 6 ins. deep, flows W. Leave cultivation, enter sagebrush, bears E. and W. Ascend.	
4.00	About 40 ft. above point of ascent. Over level land.	
4.95	Fence bears E. and W.	
4.98	To Cor. No. 4, identical with Cor. No. 1 of H. E. S. No. 73 (accepted), which is a quartzite stone, firmly set, 15 x 5 ins., showing 10 ins. above ground, mkd. 1-HES-73 on the NE. face and a cross (x) on the top and witnessed by pits and a mound of earth. I mark this stone 4-HES-223 on the SW. face for Cor. No. 4 of this survey.
