43.00	To Cor. No. 2, about 65 feet above Creek, for which I set a lava stone, 24 x 12 x 8 ins., 6 ins. in the ground to bedrock, supported by a mound of stone, mkd. 2-HES-227 on the side facing the claim and a cross (x) on the top for Cor. No. 2 of this survey. No bearing objects available, pits impracticable. Raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. dist., within the claim. Thence North Ascend over sagebrush land.
7.00	About 75 ft. above Cor. No. 1. Descend.
29.35	Road bears E. and W.
44.30	Road bears E. and W.
78.29	Road bears NW. and SE.
79.91	Fence bears NW. and SE.
79.99	To Cor. No. 3, about 135 ft. below point of descent, identical with Cor. No. 6 of H. E. Survey No. 64 (survey accepted), which is a wooden post 4 ins. sq., showing 12 ins. above the ground, mkd. 6-HES-64 on the East face with a tack in the top, and properly witnessed by pits and mound of earth. I mark this post 3-HES-227 on the S. face for Cor. No. 3 of this survey and dig pit, 24 x 24 x 12 ins., crosswise on the line, south 7 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. dist., within the claim. No bearing objects available. This Cor. is also identical with Cor. No. 3 of H. E. Survey No. 210 (approved).
