chains

- 16.00 About 65 ft. above dry wash.
Descend gentle slope.
- 40.01 To Cor. No. 7, about 50 ft. below point of descent,
previously mkd. by a temporary stake, in place
of which I set a quartzite stone, 24 x 10 x 8
ins., 14 ins. in the ground, over broken glass,
for Cor. No. 7 of this survey; mkd. 7-HES-230
on the side facing the claim, and a cross (x) on
the top; and raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base,
2 ft. high, 3 1/2 ft. dist., within the claim.
Pits impracticable, No bearing objects available.
Thence
N. 0° 38' E.,
On a true line through the center of Section 1.
Descend over sagebrush land.
- 7.75 Dry wash, course, NW.
- 13.20 Fence bears E. and W.,
- 15.02 Dry wash, course NE., about 85 ft. below Cor. No. 7.
Ascend.
- 16.27 Ridge bears E. and W., about 10 ft. above dry wash.
Descend.
- 17.67 Ditch 6 lks. wide, 6 ins. deep, course W.
- 19.62 Dry wash, course NW.
- 20.02 To Cor. No. 8, about 50 ft. below point of descent,
identical with the 1/4 cor. bet. Secs. 1 and 36,
Tps. 28 and 29 N., R. 56 E., (survey accepted),
which is a quartzite stone, firmly set, heretofore,
described. I chisel a cross (x) on the top of
this stone for chaining and angle point for Cor.
No. 8 of this survey, and alongside to the SE.
set a quartzite stone, 24 x 8 x 8 ins., 14 ins.
