	Ascend over sagebrush land.	
8.50	About 20 ft. above Cor. No. 4. Rocky ridge bears N. and S.	
	Descend.	
11.75	Fence bears N. and S., about 100 ft. below rocky ridge. Over level bottom land.	
12.40	Leave sagebrush, enter willows, bear N. and S.	
16.61	Sheep Creek, 20 lks/ <sup>wide</sup> 1 ft. deep, flows N.	
17.50	Leave willows, enter sagebrush bears N. and S.	
19.35	Leave bottom land. Ascend.	
22.80	Ditch, 2 lks wide, 6 ins. deep, course S.	
23.15	Fence bears NW and SE.	
23.62	To Cor. No. 5, about 100 ft. above point of ascent, for which I set a lava stone, 24 x 8 x 6 ins., over a lava stone, 3 x 2 x 1 ins., mkd. with a cross (x) for Cor. No. 5 of this survey; mkd. 5-HES-237 on the NE. face, and a cross(x) on the top; and raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. dist. within the claim. No bearing objects available, pits impracticable. Thence	
	Descend over sagebrush land.	
2.90	Fence bears NW and SE.	
15.90	Ditch, 2 lks. wide, 6 ins. deep, course SE.	
19.60	Spring branch 2 lks. wide, 2 ins. deep, course E., about 35 ft. below Cor. No. 5 ascend.	
22.40	Fence bears E. and W.	
23.70	To Cor. No. 6, about 100 ft. above spring branch, and previously mkd. by a temporary stake, on the Nevada-Idaho state line I remove this stake and in its place set a lava stone, 24 x 12 x 8 ins., 24 ins. in the ground, over a lava stone, 2 x 2 x 1 ins. mkd. with a cross (x) for closing cor. and Cor. No. 6
