It being the consolidated Mineral deposit claim of the Pacific,  
Borax, Salt and Soda Co., and the Mining Premises Appertaining Thereto  
Situated in Columbus Mining District, County of Esmeralda,

And

State of Nevada.

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Beginning at a pine post, 4 inches by 4 inches by 3 feet and 6 inches  
long, set in mound of earth, marked post No.1, "Beginning", U.S.S.No.  
38, consolidated "P.B.S. and S. Co." From which the 1-4 section  
corner between sections 16 and 17, Twp.3 N.R. 38 E. bears N. 64°-25'  
E. 23.28 chs. distant, section corner common to sections 16-17-20-  
and 21, twp.3 N.R.38E. S.33°-15' E. 36.50 chs. distant, and Mineral  
monument No.1, N. 14°-40' W.20.14 chs. distant. Thence,  
south, Var.16°-15' E. 19.98 chs. to post No.2 in mound of earth.  
Thence,

west Var.16°-25' E. 41.27 chs. to post No. 3, in mound of earth.

Thence,

north Var.16°-50' E. 40.00 chs. to post No.4 in mound of  
earth from which post No.4 of county survey location No.176,  
bears S.13°- 15' W. 5.44 chs. distant.

Thence, east Var. 16°-25' E. 41.27 chs. to post No. 5 in mound of  
earth from which 1-4 section corner between 16-17 is S.64°-45' E.
