- Beginning at Cor. No. 1, identical with a cor. of the loc. and with Cor. No. 2, U.S.S. No. 1812, Old Maid lode, a pine post 4 ins. sq. 4 ft. long, set 24 ins. in the ground surrounded by a mound of earth, scribed "2-1812" and "1-2069"; whence cor. to sec.s 6 and 7, Tp. 44 N., R. 56 E. bears S.  $68^{\circ}31'$  E. 7664.8 ft., a granite rock 12 x 8 x 6 ins. above ground with mound of rock west, marked with 1 notch on N. and 5 on S. edges; and the cor. to sec.s 1-2-11 and 12, Tp. 44 N., R. 55 E., (suspended) bears S.  $9^{\circ}8'$  E. 822.8 ft., a granite rock 10 x 7 x 7 ins. above the ground with mound of rock west and marked with 5 notches on S. and 1 on E. edges.
