1896.

A pine post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, set 18 ins. in
the ground with mound of earth around it, scribed 2148.1.
P. (W. P.)

Witness Post is 2.8 ft. North of Stone that marks the
 $1/4$ Cor. whence

Location Cor. rock bears S. 63° . W. 92 ft.

Thence East.

Va. 18° . E.

Descend side hill.

64.0 Cross rocky ridge.

155.0 Cross wagon road bears N. 40° . E.

660.0 To Cor. No. 2.

Which is 1 in. iron pin 18 ins. long, driven in the ground
level with the surface of the road which bears S. 40° . E.
13 ft., N. is witness post, pine, 4 ft. long, 4 ins.
square set 18 ins. in the ground with mound of rock around
it, scribed W. C. 2148.2P- whence

Granite blow out bears S. 86° . $45'$. W.

East end of stamp mill bears S. 48° . $32'$. W.

Location Cor. rock bears N. 40° . E. 224 ft.

230.0 Cross California Creek, 20 ft. wide and 3 ft. deep, dry.

290.0 Cross wagon road bears East.

Granite boulder bears S. 55° . $18'$. E. 156 ft., chiseled 2148.X.
