

U. S. SURVEY No. 2184, GOLD BUG PLACER  
Feet.

Beginning at Cor. No. 1, a granite rock 24 x 12 x 6 ins. set 12 ins. in the ground chiseled "2184-1" with X at cor. point, raise a mound of earth and rock alongside; this cor. is on the line bet. sec.s 25 and 36, T. 44 N., R. 52 E., at 1980.0 ft. West of the Cor. to sec.s 25-30-31 and 36, a granite rock 12 x 8 x 5 ins. above the ground, marked with 1 notch on the south and 5 on the north faces, and set in a small mound of earth. ( I retrace this line West and search for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. which I am unable to find, and at 5280.0 ft. I find the cor. to sec.s 25-26-35- and 36, a cottonwood tree properly marked but lying on the ground.) Cor. No. 1 is identical with the loc. cor.

3960.00 To cor. No. 2, a limestone 26 x 14 x 4 ins. set 12 ins. in the ground, chiseled "2184-2", with X at cor. point, raise a mound of earth and rock alongside, identical with loc. cor. Cor. No. 1, U.S.S. No. 60, Bonanza Queen lode, and Cor. No. 1, U.S.S. No. 61, Bonanza lode, bears S. 52° 45' W. 2806.2 ft. dist., a hewed cottonwood post 4 ins. sq. 30 ins. above ground, scribed "U.S.S.60 - Cor 1" on N.E. face and "U S S 61 - Cor 1" on N.W. face.

Thence East

330.00 To cor. No. 3, a limestone 24 x 8 x 4 ins. set 12 ins. in ground and chiseled "2184-3" with X at cor. point, raise a mound of rock alongside; from this cor. Cor. No. 1 of U.S.S. No. 38, Columbia lode and Cor. No. 1 of U.S. S. No. 39, Infidel lode, bears S. 32° 26' E. 1721.8 ft. dist. a hewed cottonwood post 4 ins. sq. 30 ins. above ground scribed "U.S S 38 Cor 1" on S.W. face and "U S S 39 Cor 1" on N. W. face. Cor. No. 3 is identical with loc. cor.
