Bearings.

Latitude.

was obtained by the use of the Saegmuller Solar attachment which gave $38^{\circ} 04' N.$ Lat.

The U. S. Coast and Geodetic Survey gave the Latitude as $38^{\circ} 04' 04'' N.$
