Description of Corners.

The E. 1/4 Cor., Sec. 34, T.3 N., R.42 E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, is a porphyry stone 16 x 10 ins. and 4 ins. thick, scratched 1/4 to the West. (not chiseled) surrounded by a monument of stone.

Cor. No. 6, Sur. No. 2193 C. B. & Q. lode, is a pine post 4-1/2 ft. long, 4 ins. square, set 18 ins. in the ground, in mound of earth and stone, scribed 6-2193.

Cor. No. 4, Sur. No. 2190 Paymaster lode, is a pine post 4-1/2 ft. long, 4 ins. square, set 18 ins. in the ground, in mound of earth and stone, scribed 4-2190.

Cor. No. 4, Survey No. 2130 O.K. lode, is a pine post 4-1/2 ft. long, 4 ins. square, set 18 ins. in the ground in mound of earth and stone, scribed 4-2130.

Cor. No. 6, Survey No. 2129 Grand Trunk lode, is a pine post 4-1/2 ft. long, 4 ins. square, set 18 ins. in the ground in mound of earth and stone, scribed 6-2129.

Cor. No. 1, Sur. No. 2131 Cabin lode, is a pine post 4-1/2 ft. long, 4 ins. square, set 18 ins. in the ground in mound of earth and stone, scribed 1-2131.

Cor. No. 1, Sur. No. 2192 Deming lode, is a pine post 4-1/2 ft. long, 4 ins. square, set 18 ins. in the ground in mound of earth and stone, identical with S.E. Cor. American Boy Placer (unsurveyed), scribed 1-2192 and marked S.E. Cor. American Boy Placer.

Cor. No. 2, Sur. No. 2012 Sand Grass lode, is a pine porphyry stone, set in ground, chiseled x 2-2012.

Angle Cor. Wash Placer (unsurveyed) is a redwood shingle in a mound of earth, marked Angle Cor.
