## EXPENDITURE OF FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS.

I certify that the value of the labor and improvements upon this claim, placed thereon by the claimant and its grantors, is not less than five hundred dollars, and that said improvements consist of:-

No.1 A shaft, 5 by 7-1/2 ft., 20 ft. deep in solid rock, with a drift, 4 by 6 ft., running N.30°W. 8 ft. Center of shaft bears N.18°59'<sup>E</sup>W. 293.5 ft. from Cor. No.2. X

Value of shaft and drift, \$320.00

No.2 A shaft, 5 by 7 ft. 20 ft. deep in solid rock, the center of which bears N.26°52'E. 397.9 ft. from Cor.

No.2. Value, \$240.00

## I N S T R U M E N T.

This survey was made with a Buff and Berger Transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian, as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with a 400 ft. steel tape.

## R E P O R T.

Cor. No.4, Sur. No.2228, Diamond lode, is a post 4 by 6 inches, 1-1/2 ft. above ground, in mound of earth and stone, scribed 4-2228.

Cor. No.5, Sur. No.2228, Blue Grass lode, is a post 4 ins. square, 2 ft. above ground, in mound of earth, scribed 5-2228.

The N.W. Cor. of Sec. 31 is a rock in place, with 1 notch on the south and 5 notches on the north side.
