DESCRIPTION OF CORNERS.

The E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. of Sec. 33, T. 3 N., R. 42 E., of Mt. Diablo B. and M. is a porphyry stone 5x8x7 ins. above ground, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face.

The W. $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. of Sec. 33, T. 3 N., R. 42 E., of Mt. Diablo B. and M. is a sandstone 6x10x10 ins. above ground, in mound of stone, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face.

The Cor. of Secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33, is a sandstone 16x12x7 ins., in mound of stone, marked with 1 notch on S., and with 4 notches on E. edges.

Note: - The disagreements bet. these field notes, and the location certificates of the Table Mountain No. 5, Table Mountain, Table Mountain No. 2, Table Mountain No. 3, Table Mountain No. 4, Table Mountain No. 6, and Cap Shief lodes with regard to position of discovery point, and county, township and range in which located, are due to errors in the latter.
