2. A trench 3x4x74 ft. long, running N 9 W, the S.End of which bears S 87 - 20 W, 753 ft. from Cor.No.1 CAP SHIEF Lode. \$ 155.00

It is the intention of the claimant to develop the veins at its several locations through this one main shaft by means of crosscuts to the veins and drift thereon when encountered, thus opening the ore bodies at depth.

An undivided 1/7 interest is applied upon each of the locations of this survey.

The other improvements are applied upon the locations upon which they are situated.

INSTRUMENTS.

This survey was made with a Keuffel and Esser Light
Mountain Transit. The courses were deflected from the
true meridian as determined by direct observation om
Polaris at elongation. The distances were measured with
50 and 500 ft. steel tapes.

REPORT.

The E. 1/4 Cor. Sec.33, T 3 N, R 42 E, Mt.D.B. and M., is a quartz rock 4x7 ins., 8 ins. above ground, chiseled 1/4 on one side.

The W. 1/4 Cor. Sec.33, T 3 N, R 42 E, Mt.D.B. and M., is a quartz rock 4x6 ins. showing 10 ins. above ground, chiseled 1/4 on one side.

Cor.No.5 Sur.No.2484, LOTTERY Lode, is a pine post 4 ins. square, showing 3 ft. above ground, in mound of earth and stone, scribed 5-2484.

Cor.No.5 Sur.No.2521, LUCKY DOG FRACTION Lode, is a pine post 4 ins. square, showing 2-1/2 ft. above ground in mound of earth and stone, scribed 5-2521.

The corners of Sur.No.2477 are all pine posts 4 ins. square, showing 3 ft. above ground, in mound of earth and stone and scribed with respective Cor.Nos.
