INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Queen's Light mountain transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with a 300 foot steel tape.

NOTE.

The disagreements between these field notes and the location certificate is due to errors in the latter.

I affirm that I hold no interest in this claim.

REPORT.

The cor. common to Secs. ~~31-32~~ and Secs. 31-32, Tp. 6 N. R. 42 E. M. D. B. and M. is marked by a round cedar post, 2 inches in diameter, set on the southern slope of a low hill, midway between the foot and the top, surrounded by a mound of stones 3 feet in diameter, 2 feet high. Its markings are indistinct, but they appear to be R X 1, 111. IVINS.

The ~~S 1/4~~ Sec. Cor. ~~common~~ to Sec. 32, Tp. 6 and Sec. ~~5~~ ~~Tp. 5~~, N.R. 42 E. M.D.B. and M. is marked by a round cedar post 1-1/2 inches in diameter, 2 feet long, set in a mound of stones 18 inches high. Its markings are indistinct. It was identified by a knowledge of its location with reference to other known corners. Its distance from the S.W. Cor. Sec. 32 is ~~18~~ 2654.4 feet; 14.4 feet greater than it should be.
