INSTRUMENT.

This Survey was made with a Queen Light Mountain Transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with a 300 foot steel tape.

REPORT.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor. ~~corner to Secs. 5 and 32, Tps. 5~~
Tp 6 N. R. 42 E. M.D.B. & M. is a cedar stick 1-1/2
inches in diameter, 2 feet long, set in a mound of
stones 18 inches high; time has made its markings un-
readable. It was identified by a knowledge of its loca-
tion with reference to other known corners.

Cor No 1 of Survey 2118 Moley Gibson, a post 4 inches
square, properly scribed and set in a mound of earth
and stone was identified by a personal examination.

This claim is situated on low, rounded hills, devoid
of precipitous cliffs, and covered with sage brush.
