2116, Burbank Lodes Nos. 1 and 2, were identified by personal examination, each corner being marked with a pine post 4 x 4 inches, set in the earth and surrounded by a monument of earth and stone, and scribed with the number of the corner and number of the survey.

The cor. common to ~~Secs. 5-6, Tps. 5 and~~ Secs. 31-32, Tp. 6 N.R. 42 E. M.D.B. and M. is a round cedar post 2 inches in diameter, set in a mound of stones 3 feet in diameter, 2 feet high extending 2 feet above it. Time and weather have partially obliterated its markings, which appear to be R X 1, 111, IVINS.

The SW. cor. to Tp. 6 N.R. 42 E. M.D.B. and M. bears W. 5280 feet from this corner.

All lines of conflicting surveys were run direct upon the ground and found as described in the above field notes.

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
