## Instrument.

This Survey was made with a Buff and Berger No. 4 Transit.

The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observation.

The distances were measured with a 500 ft steel tape.

## Note.

The disagreement between these field notes and the amended location certificates is due to errors in the latter.

## Report.

The W.1/4Cor. Sec. 19 T.2 S., R. 43 E.M.D.M. to which connection is given consists of a stone 9 x 14 x 14 ins above ground marked 1/4 on East 1/4 on West and X on top.

Cor. No. 3 Sur. No. 2281 Beauty lode to which connection is given consists of a quartz stone 7x10x9 ins above ground in mound of earth chiseled 3-2281.

Cor. Nos. 4-5 Sur. No. 2332 Virginia and Gold Seal lodes consists of a post 4 ins square showing 2-1/2 ft above ground in mound of earth and stone scribed 4 - 5 - 2332.

The East Angle Cor. of the Rabbit Foot lode and the S.E. Cor. of the Red Butte No. 1 lode consist of posts 4 ins square showing 2-1/2 ft above ground marked with the corner and the name of the claim of which they are corners.

The S.W. Cor. of the Good Old Summer Time lode consists of a mound of earth with peg marked with the corner and name of the claim.
