I certify that the value of the labor and improvements upon this claim, placed thereon by the claimant or its grantors, is less than Five Hundred Dollars, and that said improvements consist of:-

Nº1 The Discovery Shaft, which bears N. 22°29' W. 364.6 ft. from Cor. No. 1, 4 x 6 ft., 30 ft. deep, of which the lower 10 ft. was sunk under the present location.

O T H E R I M P R O V E M E N T S .

In addition to sinking the first 20 feet of the above shaft, prior locators of this claim have sunk a Shaft which bears from Cor. No. 4, N. 58°6' E. 399.2 ft., 4 x 6 ft., 25 ft. deep; and an Incline shaft, 4 x 6 ft., 20 ft. deep, which bears from Cor. No. 4, N. 50°48' E. 383.9 ft.

L O C A T I O N .

This claim is located in the center of section 32, Tp. 5 S., R. 40 E., and embraces portions of each ¼ Thereof.

I N S T R U M E N T .

This survey was made with a J.C.Sala Light Mountain Transit fitted with a Burts' Solar Attachment, and all courses were deflected from a true meridian determined by solar observation.

All distances were measured with a 100 foot steel tape.

R E P O R T .

The cor. to sec.s 4-5-32 and 33, on the S. bdy. of Tp. 5 S., R. 40 E., is a limestone 13 x 8 x 5 ins. set in a small mound of rock and properly marked.

U.S. Loc. Mon. No. 123 is a pine post 5 ins. in diam. 6 ft. long, set in a mound of rock 5 ft. base and 5 ft.
