EXPENDITURE OF FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS.

 INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Buff and Berger transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations, the details of which were returned with my notes of Sur.No.2394.

The distances were measured with 200 ft., and 300 ft. steel tapes.

 REPORT.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec.cor.on the south boundary of sec.30, T. 35 N., R. 31 E., Mt.Diablo B. and M.is a red sandstone 10' x 16' x 6' ^{inches}, marked " $\frac{1}{4}$ " on top.
