The other improvements described above are credited to the respective locations upon which they are located.

OTHER IMPROVEMENTS

A hoist and blacksmith shop which bears from Cor. No. 2 Pompeii lode, $N25^{\circ}W.364$ ft.

A bunkhouse which bears from Cor. No. 3 Pompeii lode $N 40^{\circ}58'W.448$ ft.

A cookhouse the SE corner of which bears from the discovery monument of the Pompeii lode $N.73^{\circ}10'W.195.8$ ft.

A residence which bears from Cor. No. 1 American Belle lode $N.70^{\circ}10'W. 109.2$ ft.

NOTE: The discrepancies existing between this survey and the amended location certificates are due to errors in the latter.

INSTRUMENT

This survey was made with a Buff and Berger transit No. 2. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by an observation of Polaris at elongation.

The distances were measured with 100 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.

REPORT

The SE. Cor. of Sec 22, T, 28 S, R. 63 E., M. D. M. reported in this survey, is described as follows: a pine post 4 ins. square, projecting 2 ft. above a mound of stone, marked: T 28 S S 23 on NE., R 63 E S 26 on SE., S 27 on SW. and S 22 on NW. face.

Corner No. 2 Independence lode Sur. No. 2094, is a pine post 4 ins. square, scribed 2-2094, is set in a mound of stone and earth and projects $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. above it.

The NE. Cor. of the Albert Blanche lode, unsurveyed, which is identical with the SE. Cor. of the Bonetti lode unsurveyed, is a pine post 4 ins. square, and projects $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. above a large mound of stone and earth.

The NE. corner Bonetti lode, unsurveyed, is a pine post 4 ins. square and projects $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. above a large mound of stone and earth.
