This survey was made with a Gurley Light Mountain Transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with 100 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.

Note: The disagreement between these field notes and the amended location certificates with regard to the courses of the boundary lines are due to errors in the latter.

Report: The $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor. between sections 4 and 5, T.6 S., R.41 E., M. D. B. and M. is a stone $6 \times 8 \times 14$ ins. above ground marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on the east side.
