I hereby certify that the value of the labor and improvements upon this claim, placed thereon by the claimant or his grantors, is not less than Five Hundred Dollars, and that said improvements consist of --

- No. 1 A tunnel 5 x 7 ft. 175 ft. long, course N. 65° W., the portal of which bears from Cor. No. 3 N. 40° E., 270 ft.
This tunnel is entirely in vein matter. Value \$1000.00
- No. 2 A tunnel 5 x 7 ft. 41 ft. long in rock, course N. 35° W., the portal of which bears N. 1° W., 380 ft. from Cor. No. 3.
Value \$ 300.00
- No. 3 A tunnel 4 x 6-1/2 ft. 50 ft. long, course S. 35° E., in vein matter, the portal of which bears S. 9° E., 575 ft. from Cor. No. 1, Value \$ 300.00

OTHER IMPROVEMENTS.

A tunnel portal bears N. 12° W., 450 ft. from Cor. No. 3.

This is an old working of earlier and abandoned location.

The tunnel is caved and course and dimensions unknown.

INSTRUMENT.

This survey is made with an A. Lietz transit.

The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by Polaris observation at the N.W. Cor. of Sec. 27.

Report

The N.W. Cor. of Sec. 27 is a stone 6 x 12 x 12 ins. above ground, chiseled with two grooves on the S. and 3 grooves on the E. edges, with a mound of stone alongside.
