

The N.E. Cor. No. 2 of the Manatauwah Claim (unsurveyed) is a post 4 ins. sq., set in a mound of stone and marked Manatauwah (2).

The S.E. Cor. No. 1 Manatauwah Claim (unsurveyed), is a post 4 ins. sq., set in a mound of stone and marked Manatauwah (1).

The N.W. Corner Manatauwah Claim (unsurveyed) is a mound of stone (unmarked) but identified by N.C. Carmichael, the Claimant.

The Empire corners at the North end are identical with the location corners on the Free Coinage Claim.

The N.W. Cor. of Sec. 37 is a stone 6 x 12 x 12 ins. above ground, chiseled with two grooves on the S. and 3 grooves on the E. edges, with a mound of stone along side.
