2 An engine house 26 x 30 ft. the S.E. Cor. of which bears from Cor. No. 1 Lottery Lode N. 4° 18' W. 263.0 ft., long side N. 30° E.

3 A blacksmith shop 10 x 20 ft., S.E. Cor. of which bears from Cor. No. 1 Lottery Lode N. 15° 58' W. 204.3 ft., long side N. 20° W.

All the above described improvements belong to claimant herein.

INSTRUMENTS

This survey was made with an A. Lietz Co. Transit, No. 0522.

The courses were deflected by plate angles from the true meridian as established by the U. S. Coast and Geodetic Survey and marked by stone piers set about one mile apart.

The distances were measured with a 650 ft. standard steel tape.

REPORT

Description of Corners.

The W. 1/4 Cor. Sec. 34, T. 3 N., R. 42 E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, is a porphyry rock 4 x 8 ins., 9 ins. above ground, chiseled 1/4 to the West. Cor. No. 1, Sur. No. 2276 Table Mountain No. 5 Lode is a pine post, 2' 2 x 4's nailed together, 4 ft. high above ground, scribed 1-2276.

Cor. No. 4 Sur. No. 2477 Spike Lode, identical with Cor. No. 4, Sur. No. 2276 Table Mountain No. 5 Lode is a pine post 3 ft. 3 ins. high above ground and mound of earth and stone, scribed 4-2276 and 4-2477.

Cor. No. 2, Sur. No. 2187 Cats Paw Mine Lode is a pine post 4 ins. square, 3 ft. high above ground, in mound of earth and stone, scribed 2-2187.

Cor. No. 3, Sur. No. 2185 Short Lode, is a pine post 4 ins. square, 3 ft. high above ground, in mound of earth and stone, scribed 3-2185.

Cor. No. 4, Sur. No. 2185 Short Lode, is a pine post 4 ins. square, 3 ft. high above ground, in mound of earth and stone, scribed 4-2185.
