

Tunnels No. 1 and No. 2, described and included in the estimate of expenditure, continued in their present course will intersect at depth the Last Chance Mining Claim vein, and the cross cut from Tunnel No. 2 continued in its present course will intersect the vein of the New York Mining Claim at depth and thus the entire claim will be most advantageously and economically developed.

Other Improvements

There are none, except a line of irregular stripping along the ledge or lode line and commencing at about the breast of Tunnel No. 1 and extending to line 2-3 Little Johnny Mining Claim Lode

Instrument

This Survey was made with a Gurley Fifth Mountain Transit. The Courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct Solar observations. The distances were measured with 100 ft. and 300 ft. steel tapes

Description of Corners

The Corner of Sections 22, 23, 26 and 27, T. 23 N R. 62 E of the Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian, is a quartzite rock 18" x 9" x 9" ins. with 2 notches on the South and 2 notches on the East side, with rock monument beside it.

This was the nearest and only Corner of the Public Land Survey that I could find, though I made most diligent search for others.
