TALLISMAN NO. 2 MINING CLAIM LODE.

LOCATION

This claim is located upon unsurveyed land, and more than two miles away from any corner, but would, if the public land surveys were extended, be approximately in T. 1 S., R. 70 E. of the Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian.

EXPENDITURE OF FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS.

None are returned herewith, as the claimants or their grantors have not, up to the present, done the necessary amount of labor and improvements.

OTHER IMPROVEMENTS.

A shaft which bears from Cor. No. 2 S. $7^{\circ} 55' W.$ 380.0 ft., 4 x 6 ft., 8 ft. deep in earth and rock; belongs to claimants.

INSTRUMENT

This survey was made with a Gurley Light Mountain Transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian, as determined by direct solar observations.

The distances were measured with 100 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.

REPORT.

Mile Post No. 237, on the Utah and Nevada State Boundary Line, is a pine post 3 ins. diam., standing $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. above a stone monument 4 ft. base and 2 ft. high, scribed on east side Utah, on West side Nevada, on north side 237, and on South side L.W. 37.
