

## Location.

This claim is located in the E. 1/2 of Sec. 20, T. 21 N., R. 23 E., M. D. M.

## Expenditure of Five Hundred Dollars.

I certify that the value of the labor and improvements upon this claim placed thereon by the claimants and their grantors is not less than Five Hundred Dollars and that said improvements consist of:

No. 1 The discovery shaft of the Black Horse lode which bears from Cor. No. 6, Black Horse lode N. 55 W. 240 ft. 4 x 6 ft. by 11 ft. deep in rock and earth.

Value \$100.

No. 2 A cut, the mouth of which bears from Cor. No. 6 Black Horse lode N. 63° W. 180 ft., 4 ft. wide, 10 ft. face, runs N. 35° W. 18 ft. to breast, in rock and earth.

Value \$100.

No. 3 A cut the mouth of which bears from Cor. No. 6 Black Horse lode S. 70° 40' W. 280 ft. wide, 8 ft. face running N. 20° W. 13 ft. to face, in rock and earth. At face of cut a shaft 4 x 6 ft. 9 ft. deep in rock.

Value of cut and shaft \$100.

No. 4 A cut the mouth of which bears from Cor. No. 1 Black Horse lode N. 85° 15' W. 85 ft. 4 ft. wide, 12 ft. face, running N. 62° W. 40 ft. face, in earth and rock. At face of cut a tunnel 4 x 6 ft. runs N. 52° W. 20 ft. to face in rock.

Value of cut and tunnel \$350.

No. 5 A shaft which bears from Cor. No. 1, Black Horse lode, N. 65° W. 170 ft. 4 x 6 ft. 11 ft. deep in earth and rock.

Value \$100.

No. 1 The discovery cut of the Nolon lode the mouth of which bears from Cor. No. 2 Nolon lode S. 29° E. 180 ft., 4 ft. wide, 10 ft. face, runs S. 20° E. 15 ft. to breast, in rock and earth.

Value \$100.

No. 2 A cut in earth and rock the mouth of which bears from Cor. No. 2 Nolon lode, S. 47° E. 65 ft., 4 ft. wide, 10 ft. face, runs S. 28° 25' E. 15 ft. to the mouth of a tunnel, in rock, 5 x 7 ft., which runs S. 28° 25' E. 75 ft. to breast.

## Instrument.

This survey was made with a C. L. Berger & Sons No. 2 transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with 500 and 5 ft. steel tapes.

## Report.

The S. 1/4 Cor. Sec. 29, T 21 N. R 23 E. M. D. M. is a stone set in a mound of stone and chiseled 1/4 on the north face.

Cor. No. 2 Independence lode is a pine post 4-1/2 ft. long 4 ins. sq. set 2 ft. in the ground with mound of earth and stone scribed S. W. Cor. No. 2 Independence lode.
